## What is Flexibus?

Flexibus is a 'ring and ride' service which anyone can use. The bus follows a route set by the pre-booked requests of passengers.

All buses are fully accessible, with space for wheelchairs, child buggies and shopping.

## Where does it go?

Flexibus connects Norfolk villages with local towns. The service is ideal for shopping trips and health appointments as well as social activities like meeting friends, library and sports centre visits. You can even use Flexibus to make onward connections to Norwich, London and beyond.

## How does it work?

Simply ring your local service up to seven days before you want to travel. The operator will take your journey details and confirm your pick up point and time. Disabled people and people with mobility issues can request a home pick up and drop off.

## What does it cost?

Flexibus offers a very convenient, local service for the price of a regular bus fare. There are reduced fares for those who buy 10 Flexi passes at once, and children under 16.

Norfolk Concessionary passes are also accepted.

## When does it run?

### Swaffham area:

Every Week: Monday to Friday  
07:00—19:00

Saturday scheduled service available for set villages into Swaffham and then into King's Lynn.

## When can I book?

Booking hours are Monday to Friday, 9:00am – 4:30pm (not including bank holidays) and should be made by 3pm the day before you wish to travel. If you wish to travel on a Monday, book by 3pm on the Friday before.
